At the next meeting, the **Committee will vote on how you will prioritize the projects for placement within the six year time-frame of 2015 to 2020**. Prioritizing projects is somewhat subjective and can be done by various ways. Two recommended methods of prioritization are:

<u>OPTION A Project Prioritization Rank Criteria</u> 1-5 scale with Project placed into respective CIP years for implementation:

- 1 <u>Urgent</u> (Years 1-2)
- 2 Needed soon (Years 3-4)
- 3 Necessary (Years 5-6)
- 4 Can wait (After 6 Years)
- 5 <u>Unnecessary</u>

By identifying the priority (1- Urgent) and attaching a year span (Years 1-2 in the CIP) to the prioritization method, the project will placed into the CIP accordingly. The key to prioritization is to be consistent year after year as the CIP is updated regardless of the prioritization method used. Want an **OPTION C?** 

#### **OPTION B** Project Prioritization Rank Criteria

1-6 scale with Project descriptions and placed into respective CIP years for implementation

- 1 <u>Urgent:</u> Cannot be delayed; needed immediately for public health and safety. (Years 1-2)
- 2 Necessary: Needed to maintain basic level of community services. (Years 3-4)
- 3 <u>Desirable</u>: Needed to improve quality or level of services. (Years 5-6)
- 4 <u>Deferrable</u>: Can be placed on hold until after 6 year period. (After 6 years)
- 5 <u>Premature:</u> Needs more research, time, planning, or coordination.
- 6 <u>Inconsistent:</u> Contrary to land use planning or community development goals or is not funded by the Town or does not meet criteria
